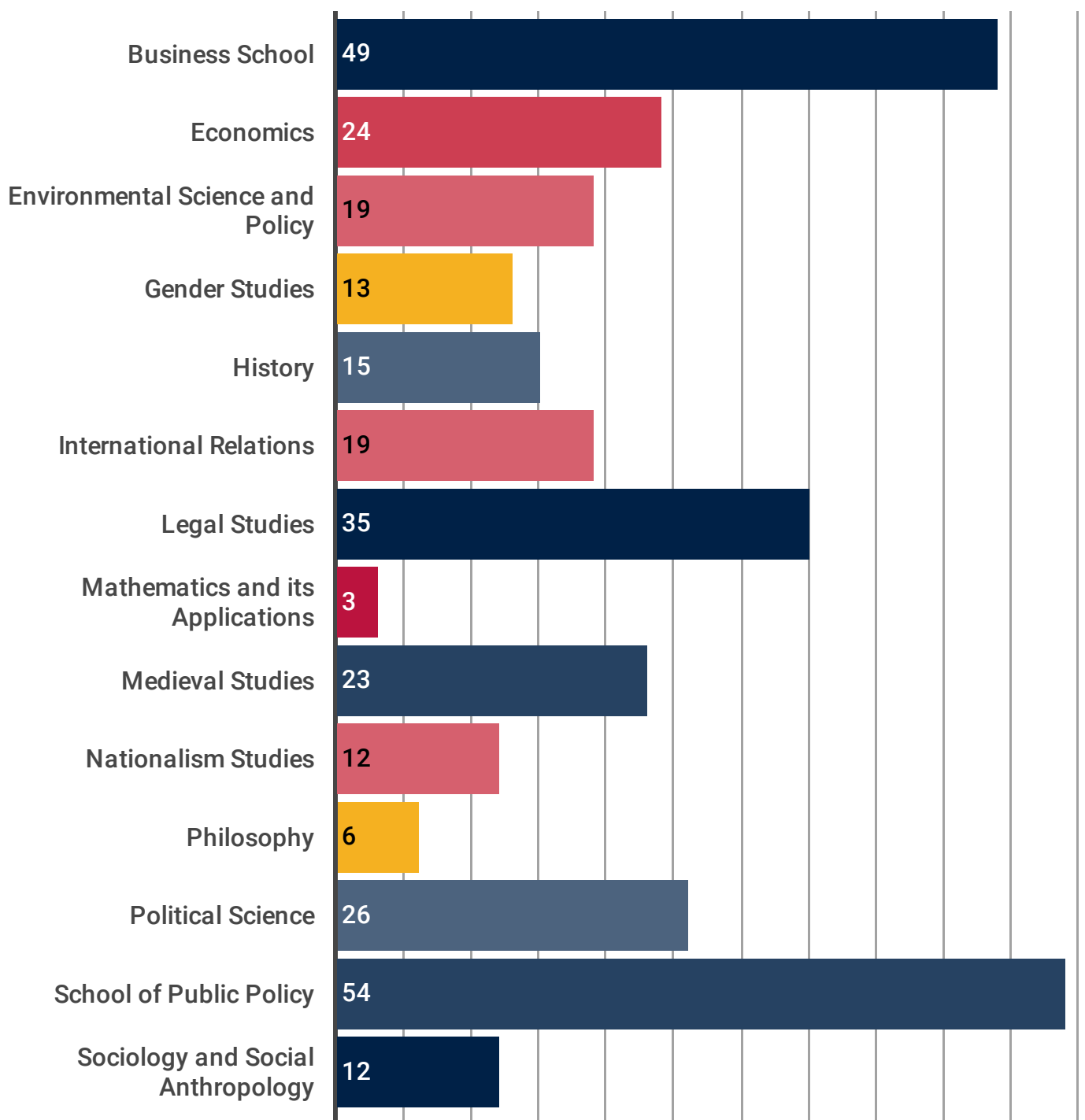

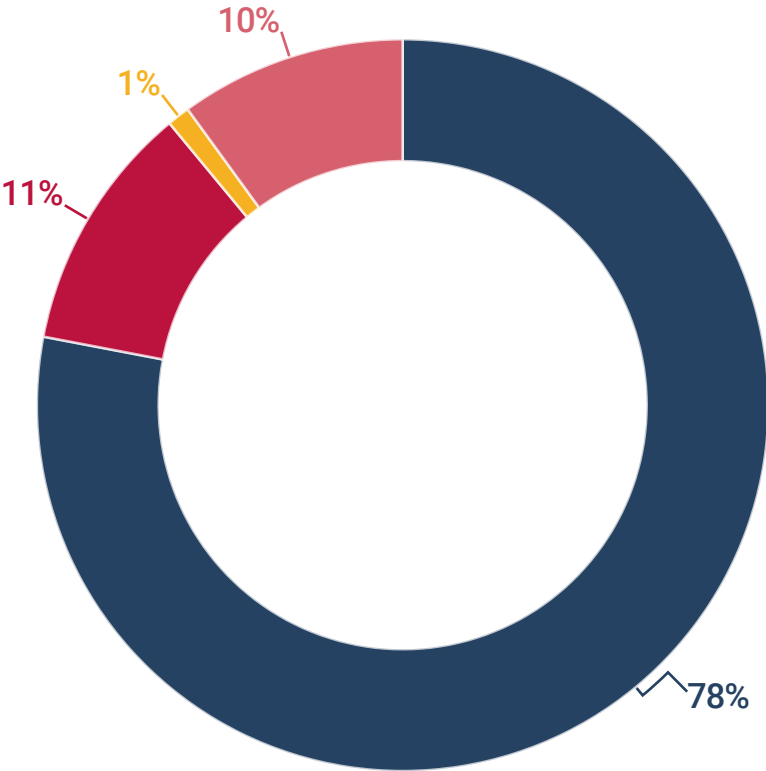

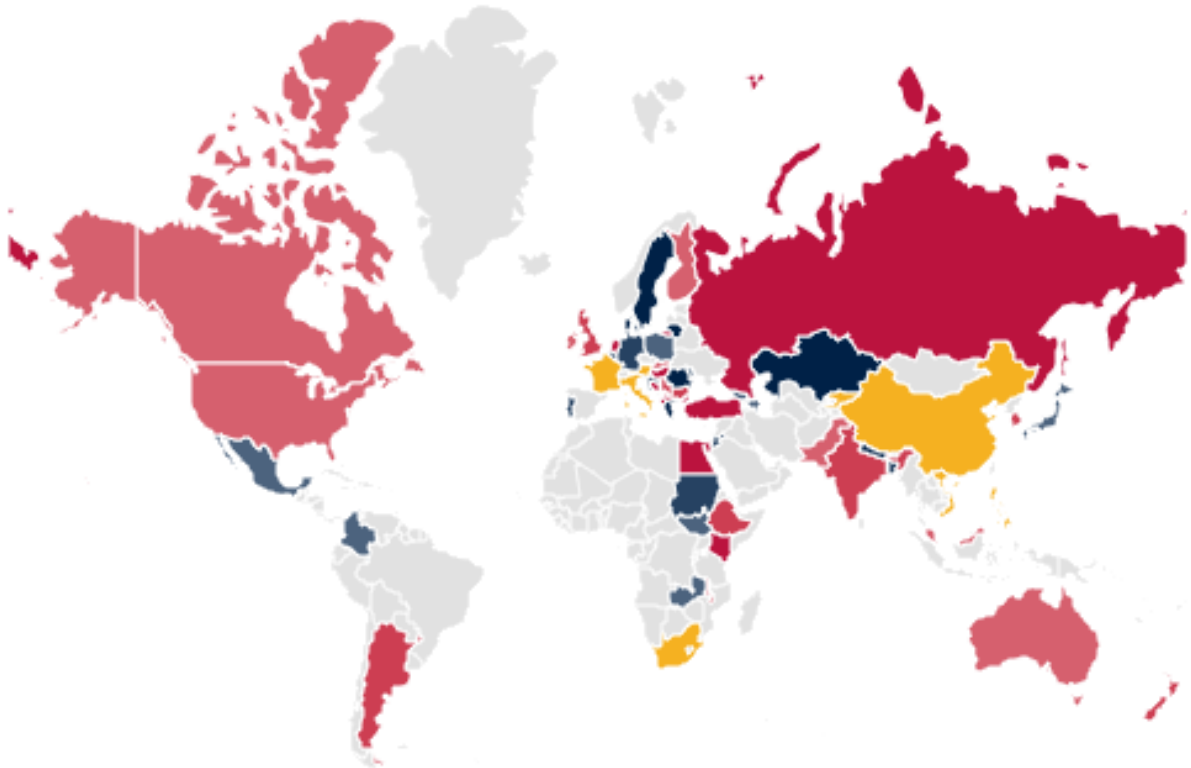
Employment Status

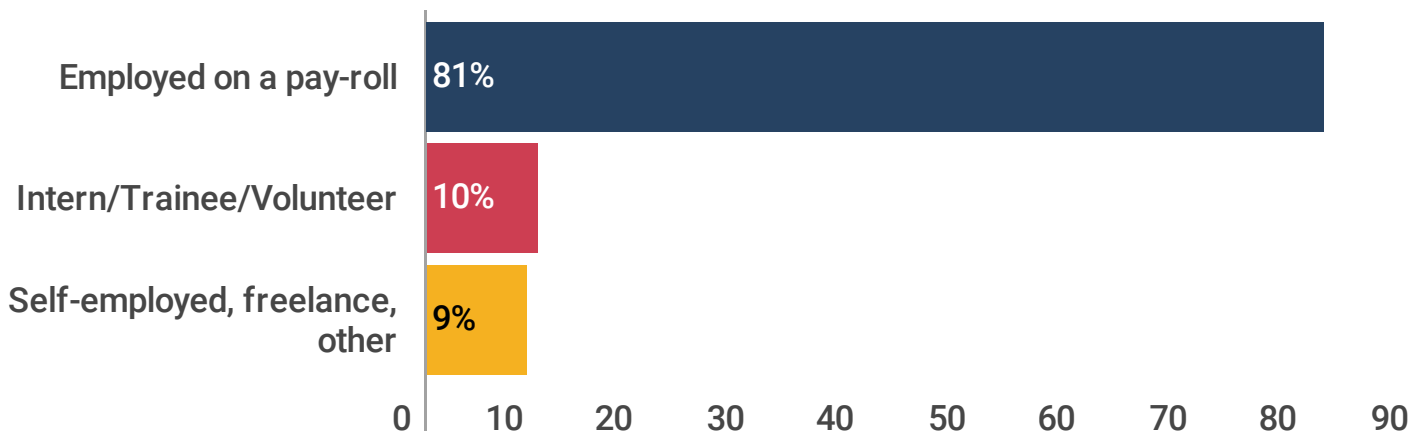

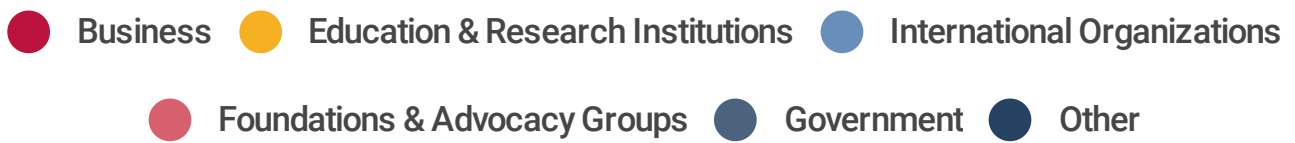
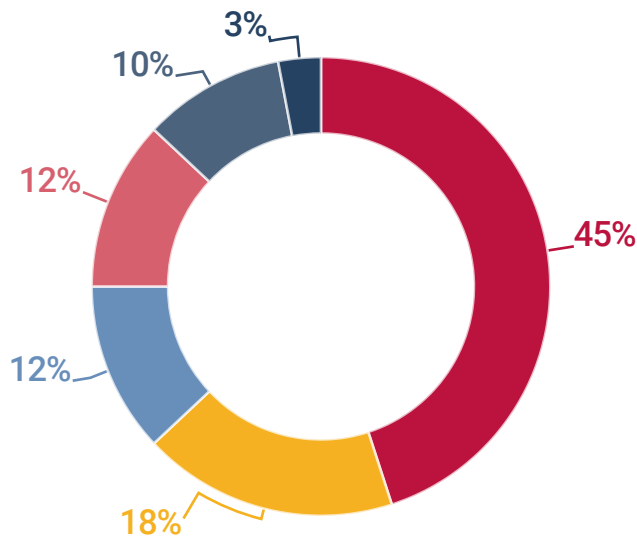

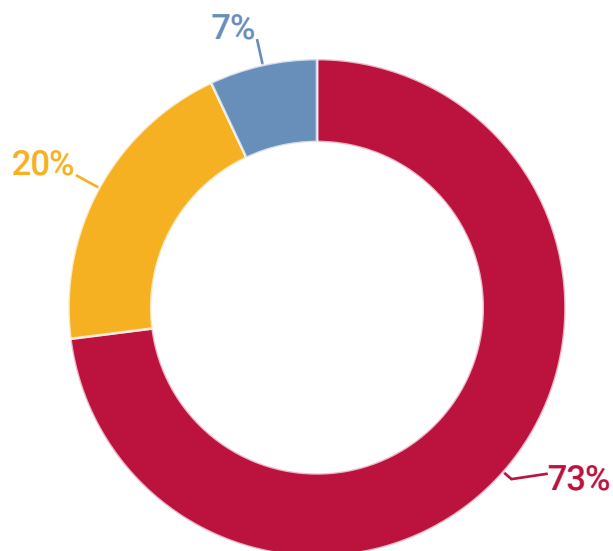
Type of Employment



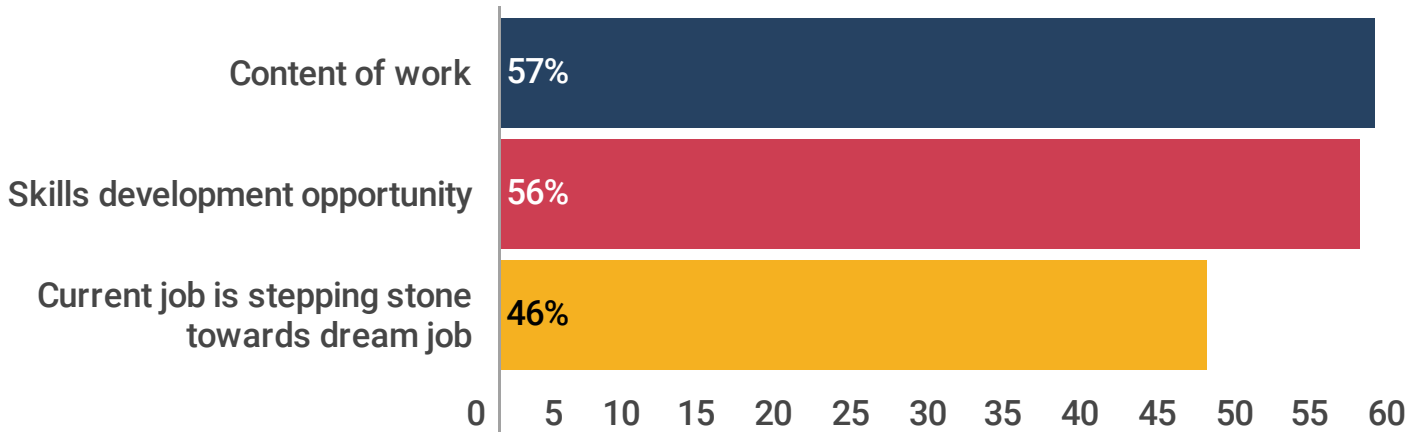
Area of Employment

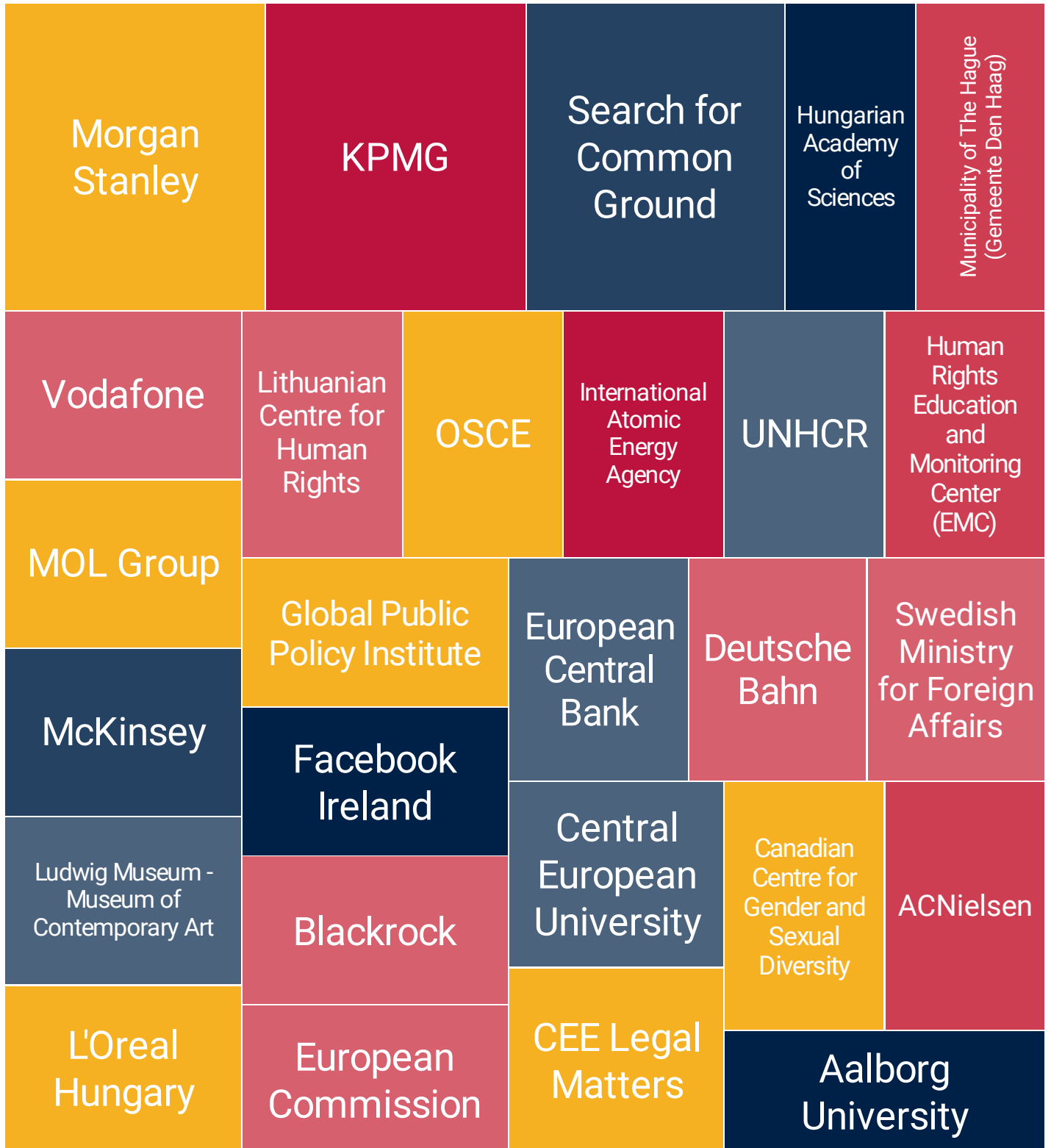

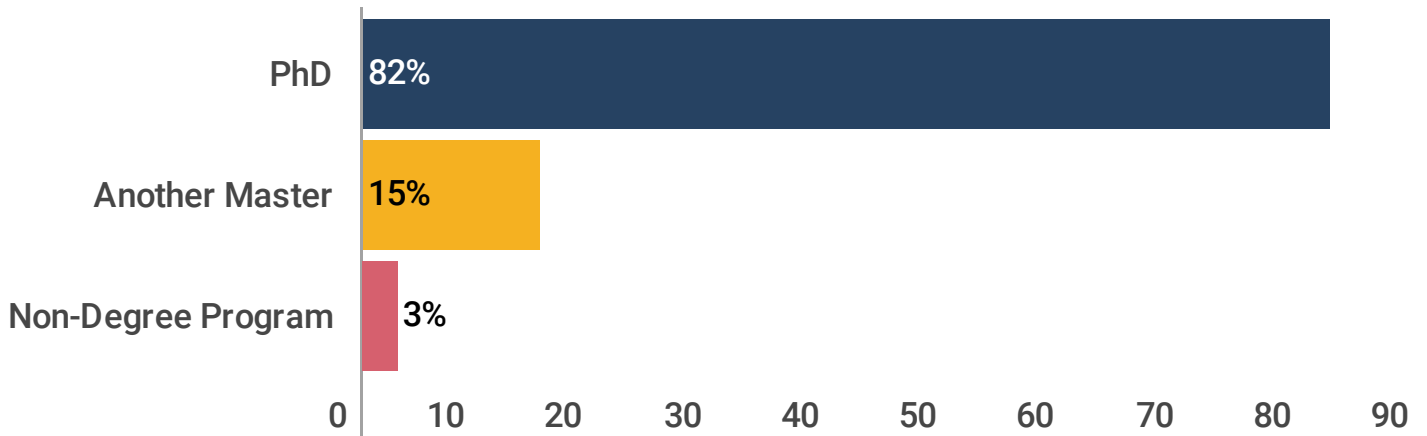

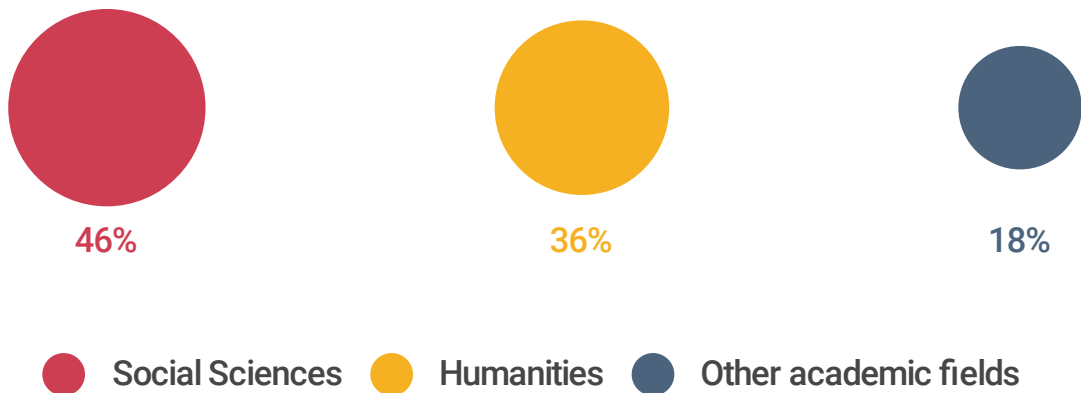

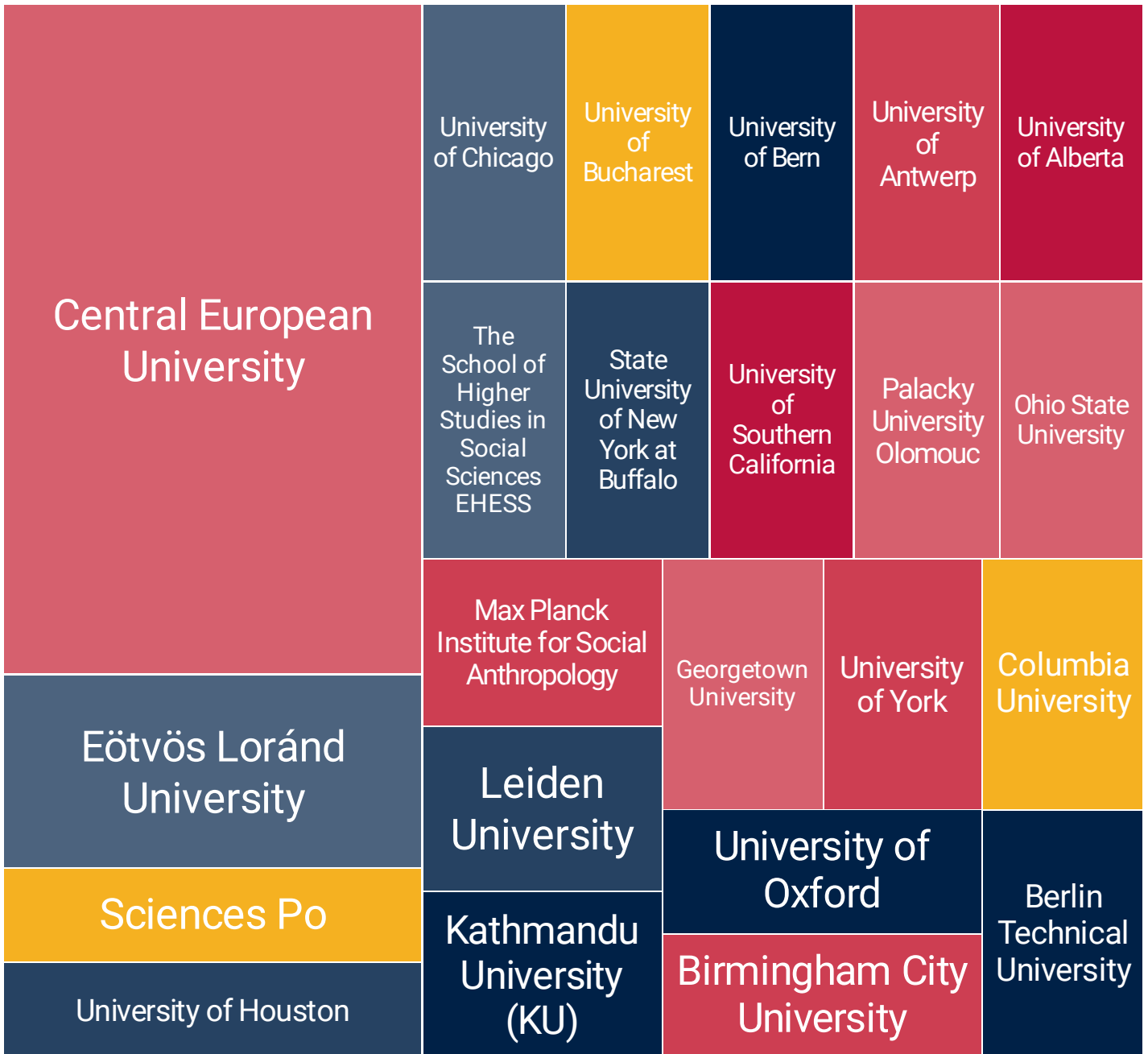

Field of Study



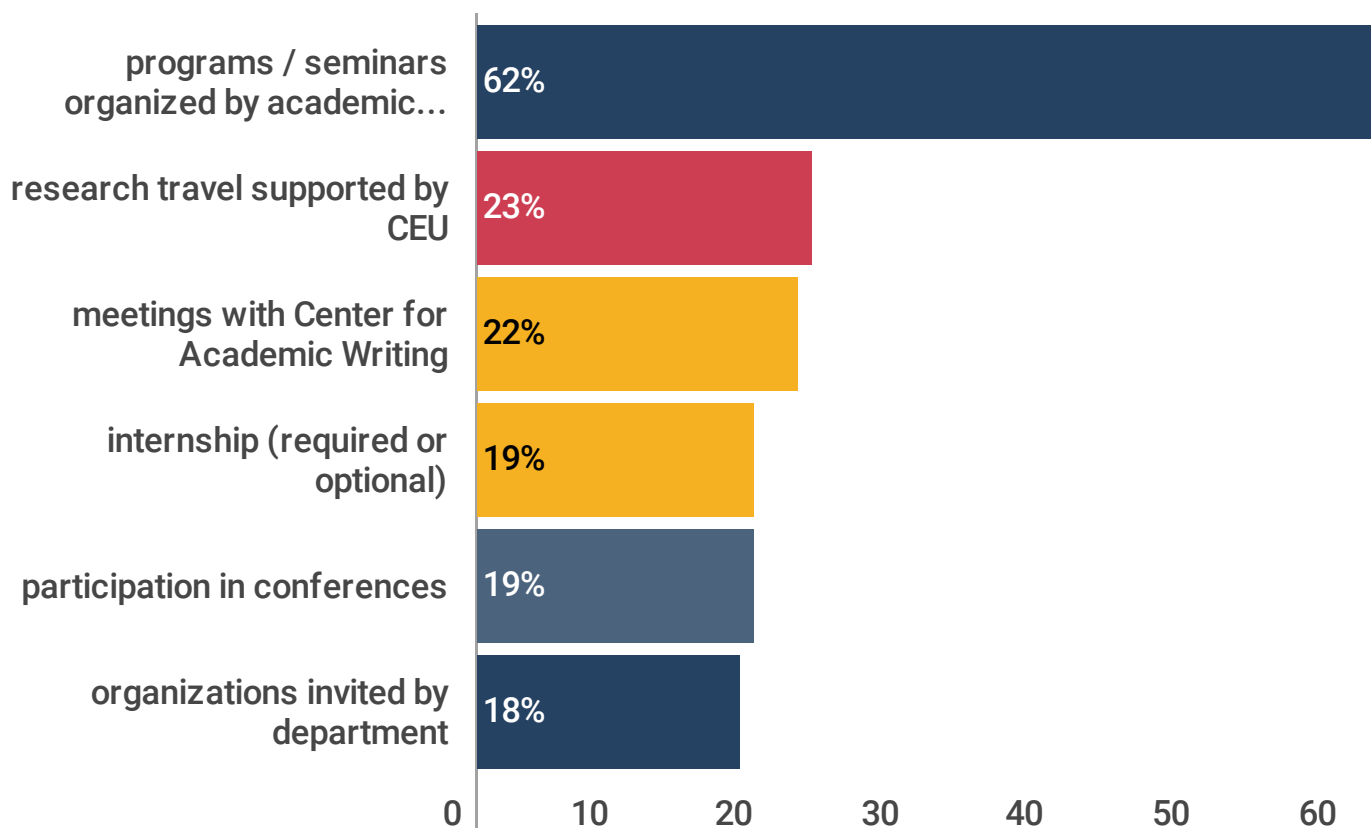

This report is based on analysis of data collected through the Career Services Office's 2017 First Destination Survey, gathered from 2017 CEU master's graduates during the period January-June 2018. Of 591 master's graduates, 310 responded to the survey, making for a response rate of 52%.
